On behalf of the Occupational Safety and Health State Plan Association (OSHSPA), I would like to take this opportunity to nominate Anne Soiza, Assistant Director for the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries, over Division of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) for re-appointment as a Public-Sector representative to the National Advisory Committee on Occupational Safety and Health (NACOSH).

She also currently serves as chair of the NACOSH on Occupational Safety and Health which advises the U. S. Secretaries of Labor and Health and Human Services. As the Chair of NACOSH she is a proven leader and an active member. Her knowledge, experience, and expertise have proven to be invaluable to the committee and associated work groups. Additionally, Anne is highly regarded among her peers in the Occupational Safety and Health State Plan Association and among safety and health professionals across Washington. Since Anne has been a

member of NACOSH for the past six years, her re-appointment would ensure experienced leadership, continuity and consistency as the committee continues to address critical health and safety issues.


Anne consents to this nomination and recognizes the commitment and responsibility with serving on NACOSH.
